SYNOPSIS:

On June 16, 2020 at approximately 10:00 PM, 74-year-old Stan Neff was last seen in the 8900 block of Troy Street in Spring Valley. Tonight at 5:00 PM, Mr. Neff was located at a local hospital. We thank the public for looking out for Mr. Neff, as well as our Search and Rescue volunteers.

The Sheriff's Search and Rescue (SAR) is an all-volunteer unit. Together, they perform wilderness and urban rescues, as well as search for missing and at-risk persons. Teams are available 24 hours per day to respond to local, state and federal agency requests.
