

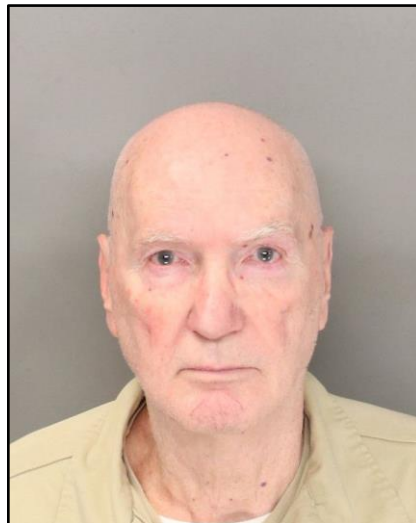

The Sheriff's Department, the District Attorney's Office and the SAFE Task Force are not responsible for the selection of the proposed site. The selection process and approval are the responsibility of the Department of State Hospitals and San Diego Superior Court.

On June 29, 2020 the Department of State Hospitals (DSH) proposed placement of Joseph Bocklett at 15077 Adams Drive, Pauma Valley CA 92061. Selection of the proposed placement location is the sole responsibility of DSH and the San Diego County Superior Court. However, under Welfare & Institutions Code section 6609.1, the public is permitted to comment on the proposed location before it is finalized by the Court.

Pauma Valley, California is an unincorporated community in the north inland area of San Diego County. Per the United States Census Bureau, the estimated population of Pauma Valley was 7,499 in 2018. The property of interest is located within the San Diego County Sheriff Department's jurisdiction, particularly the area patrolled by deputies assigned to the Valley Center Sheriff's Substation.

With the court hearing scheduled for July 31st, the SAFE Task Force will be accepting public comments about the proposed placement to be included in the formal response to the court.

The Sheriff's Department, the District Attorney's Office and the SAFE Task Force are not responsible for the selection of the proposed site. The selection process is the sole responsibility of the Department of State Hospitals and San Diego Superior Court.

You may submit your comments through any of the methods listed below. Public comment will be accepted between the dates of July 1st and July 14th. These comments will be forwarded to DSH and to the Superior Court before the hearing on this matter. Public comments may also be accepted at the hearing.
