SUBJECT: Homicide Investigation

The following information is fragmentary and has not been completely verified. It is based, in part, on hearsay and is intended for early information use rather than being a formal investigative report.

On July 4, 2020, at about 7:40 p.m., Sheriff's deputies responded to a report of a person who was shot at the 5100 block of Cedarwood Road in Bonita. When deputies arrived, they found an adult female victim who had been shot and citizens were performing CPR. Deputies learned there was a fight between several women in the parking lot of an apartment complex at 5100 Cedarwood Road just prior to the shooting. The victim was found in the parking lot.

The female was transported to a local hospital for treatment. Unfortunately, the victim did not survive. She was pronounced deceased shortly after arriving at the hospital.

The Sheriff's Homicide Unit responded and has assumed responsibility of the investigation.
