SUBJECT: Homicide Investigation – Update

LOCATION: 700 Convertible Lane, Fallbrook

DECEASED: Salvador Steven Galvan, 56-years-old

SUSPECT: Unidentified

Sheriff's Homicide detectives continued their investigation into the shooting homicide of an adult male in Fallbrook.

The Medical Examiner's Office conducted the autopsy today and has identified the victim as Salvador Steven Galvan, a fifty-six-year-old resident of Fallbrook. The victim's family has been notified of his death. The preliminary cause of death is multiple gunshot wounds and the manner of death is homicide.

Information from prior release:

On August 29, 2020, just after 12:00 p.m., Sheriff's deputies responded to 700 Convertible Lane in Fallbrook for multiple citizens hearing gunfire. When deputies arrived, they located an adult male who had been shot and was laying in front of a home. North County Fire Department responded and attempted live saving efforts. Unfortunately, the male was pronounced deceased at the scene.

The Sheriff's Homicide Unit responded and has assumed responsibility of the investigation.
