**SUSPECT:** Giovanni Rodriguez, 20-year-old

Homicide detectives continued their investigation and identified twenty-year-old Giovanni Rodriguez, a resident of Chula Vista, as the suspect in the shooting murder of Janessa Delvalle. Rodriguez was arrested and booked into San Diego Central Jail for one count of 187(a) PC – Murder.

Information from second release:

*Homicide detectives are continuing their investigation into the shooting death of a woman on July 4, 2020, which occurred at 5100 Cedarwood Road in Bonita.*

*The victim's family has been notified of her death. The victim was identified as Janessa Delvalle, a nineteen-year-old resident of Bonita. The Medical Examiner's Office conducted the autopsy. The cause of death is gunshot wound and the manner of death is homicide.*

Information from first release:

*On July 4, 2020, at about 7:40 p.m., Sheriff's deputies responded to a report of a person who was shot at the 5100 block of Cedarwood Road in Bonita. When deputies arrived, they found an adult female victim who had been shot and citizens were performing CPR. Deputies learned there was a fight between several women in the parking lot of an apartment complex at 5100 Cedarwood Road just prior to the shooting. The victim was found in the parking lot.*
