SYNOPSIS:

On October 2nd, 2020 at approximately 9:25pm, deputies from the North Coastal Sheriff's Department Transit Enforcement Unit responded to a report of a pedestrian who struck by an BNSF freight train at the Old Town Transit Station in the City of San Diego. Upon arrival, the subject was deceased. Deputies are investigating the incident and manner of death will be determined by the San Diego County Medical Examiner's Office.
