The following information is fragmentary and has not been completely verified. It is based, in part, on hearsay and is intended for early information use rather than being a formal investigative report.

Homicide detectives are continuing their investigation into the death of Nicolas Ramirez which occurred on October 30, 2020.

The Medical Examiner has completed the autopsy and the preliminary cause of death is multiple stab wounds and the manner of death is homicide.

## Information from prior release:

On October 30, 2020, at approximately 10:40 p.m., Sheriff's deputies responded to 442 Ammunition Road in Fallbrook to assist the North County Fire Department with an injured male. When deputies arrived, they found Nicolas Ramirez suffering from an unknown traumatic injury. North County Fire Department arrived and began live saving efforts. Ramirez was transported to Palomar Hospital where he was pronounced deceased.

The Sheriff's Homicide Unit responded and has assumed responsibility of the investigation.
