SUBJECT: Homicide Investigation

LOCATION: 600 Block of Pine Street, Ramona

SUSPECT: Unknown

The following information is fragmentary and has not been completely verified. It is based, in part, on hearsay and is intended for early information use rather than being a formal investigative report.

On November 5, 2020, at about 5:48 a.m., the Sheriff's Department received a report of a gunshot heard in the 600 block of Pine Street in Ramona. The reporting party found a man on the ground in front of a neighboring home.

Deputies from the Ramona Sheriff's Substation responded to the scene and began lifesaving efforts. The victim was transported to a local hospital for treatment but did not survive. The Sheriff's Homicide Unit responded to investigate the death.

The San Diego County Medical Examiner's Office will determine the cause and manner of death, as well as identification of the victim, pending the notification of his family.

The investigation is in the early stages and is ongoing. There is no one in custody for this incident.
