## **SYNOPSIS:**

Imperial Beach Deputies responded to a robbery in progress at the Chase Bank located at 1100 Palm Avenue in Imperial Beach.

The suspect entered the bank and began yelling, "Give me the money, I want one hundred dollar bills!" The suspect walked up to three different bank tellers and took an undetermined amount of money. No weapons were observed and the suspect was last seen exiting the west side doors of the bank and ran northbound on 11th Street.

A witness saw a black four door Nissan Altima occupied by two unknown females leave the area soon after the robbery.

The suspect was described as an unknown race male adult, 5'8", 140 lbs. He was wearing a black and white mask, red long sleeve hoody sweatshirt, blue jeans, and two tone black and white colored shoes. There were no injuries. ASTREA was not available due to the weather.

Deputies and detectives checked the surrounding streets for the suspect but he was not located.

The FBI was notified and they are handling the investigation.
