## **SYNOPSIS:**

On 2-12-19 at about 1720 hours, the Sheriff's Communications Center received a report of an Assault with a Deadly Weapon that occurred in the 7-Eleven parking lot located at 9365 Jamacha Blvd. in Spring Valley. Witnesses reported seeing two males engaged in a verbal dispute near the fuel pumps. The males were standing next to a vehicle described as an older Black Cadillac sedan. The argument turned physical and both males began striking each other. The two men eventually separated and one walked across the parking lot and stood next to a white sedan. The other male got into the black Cadillac. The male in the Cadillac then drove directly toward the other male and struck him with his vehicle. The male was thrown onto the hood of the Cadillac and then catapulted into the street. The male in the Cadillac fled westbound on Jamacha Blvd. The injured male was able to crawl out of the street and onto the sidewalk. The male in the Cadillac quickly turned around, drove onto the sidewalk, and attempted to run over the injured male a second time before leaving the scene eastbound on Jamacha Blvd.

Deputies arrived on scene and interviewed the injured male who identified himself as 32 year-old Kyshaun Jones. Jones is acquainted with the other male and had identified him as the suspect in a strong arm robbery that occurred earlier in the day involving Jones' brother.

Deputies conducted an extensive search but were not able to locate the suspect. Jones was transported to Scripps Mercy hospital with serious but non-life threatening injuries. The full extent of his injuries is not known at this time. Area Detectives from the Rancho San Diego Station are handling the investigation.
