The following information is fragmentary and has not been completely verified. It is based, in part, on hearsay and is intended for early information use rather than being a formal investigative report.

The Vista Detention Facility had a 45-year-old man being treated at a local area hospital for a preexisting serious medical condition. The man had been in custody since November 9, 2017, for several different charges, including attempted murder, torture, elder abuse, assault with a deadly weapon and criminal threats. The man had been on life support at the hospital, but unfortunately passed away this afternoon at approximately 12:04 hours. The Sheriff's Homicide Unit responded to investigate the death.

The San Diego County Medical Examiner's Office will conduct an autopsy to determine the cause and manner of death and notify the victim's family. The Sheriff's Homicide Unit responds to investigate all in-custody deaths. Our response is not an indication of foul play or suspicious circumstances. The investigation is ongoing.
