**SUBJECT:** Alpine Murder Investigation

**LOCATION:** 2800 Block of Victoria Drive, Alpine

**DATE/TIME:** February 23, 2019 / 2:12 p.m.

**VICTIM:** Withheld, pending family notification

**SUSPECT:** Paul Paraschak, age 42

**Updated information:**

The suspect in this case has been identified as forty-two-year-old Paul Paraschak of Alpine. Paraschak has been arrested for one count of murder and booked into the San Diego Central Jail, where he is being held without bail.

*Information from a prior release:*

*This afternoon Alpine Sheriff's deputies responded to multiple 9-1-1 calls from residents in the area of Victoria Drive and England Place, in Alpine. Callers reported hearing shots fired and seeing a man with a gun walking in the area. Deputies responded and quickly located a Caucasian male adult, matching the description of the armed male suspect. The man was detained without incident and found to be armed with two handguns.*

*Deputies located a gravely injured female adult near a vehicle parked in the 2800 block of Victoria Drive. She was pronounced deceased at the scene by Alpine Fire Department personnel.*

*The Sheriff's Homicide Unit responded and has assumed responsibility for the investigation.*

*The San Diego County Medical Examiner's Office will notify the next of kin and perform an autopsy to determine the cause and manner of death.*
