The following information is fragmentary and has not been completely verified. It is based, in part, on hearsay and is intended for early information use rather than being a formal investigative report.

This evening Sheriff's deputies were flagged down by a person reporting a shooting had just occurred in the area of Olive Street and Main Street, in Lemon Grove. At the same time, deputies also received 9-1-1 calls reporting a shooting in the area. Deputies found an adult male on the ground with severe injuries and began life saving measures. The male was transported to a local hospital by ambulance, but was pronounced deceased at 8:43 p.m. A second injured adult male was found in the area and had been apparently shot in the lower leg area. That man was treated and released by hospital staff.

The Sheriff's Homicide Unit responded and has assumed responsibility for the investigation.

The San Diego County Medical Examiner's Office will notify the next of kin and perform an autopsy to determine the man's cause and manner of death.
