SYNOPSIS:

On March 21st, 2019, at approximately 10:37 P.M., deputies from the North Coastal Sheriff's Transit Enforcement Unit responded to an AMTRAK Train vs. pedestrian collision. The collision occurred on the railroad track near the intersection of Washington Street and Hancock Street, in the city of San Diego. A southbound Amtrak Train was traveling approximately 46 miles per hour when an unidentified adult male walked onto the tracks and into the path of the train. The train was unable to stop before subsequently striking the male. The male was pronounced deceased at the scene.
