### SYNOPSIS:

On April 6 at about 306 pm, at 1275 Main St. in Ramona, a staff member of the Ramona Library called in to report a suspicious device located in front of the library. It is unknown who placed the device or precisely when the device arrived. In an abundance of caution, Ramona patrol deputies evacuated the library and surrounding businesses and requested investigators from Sheriff's Bomb/Arson to evaluate, investigate and dispose of the device. At about 430 pm, the area was cleared to return to normal business operation. There were no injuries and an investigation into who placed the device will be on-going.
