Synopsis:

On April 23, 2019, at approximately 7:50 PM, deputies from the North Coastal Sheriff's Transit Enforcement Unit responded to a report of an Amtrak Train vs. pedestrian collision. The collision occurred on the railroad tracks near Mile Post Marker 238.4 in the city of Encinitas, Ca. A southbound Amtrak Train was traveling at approximately 57 miles per hour when an adult male walked into the middle of the railroad tracks. The male was struck by the train.
