SYNOPSIS:

On June 20, 2019, at approximately 2:08 p.m., deputies from the San Diego County Sheriff's San Marcos Station, Traffic Division, responded to reports of a vehicle which collided into a pedestrian at 1607 Grandon Avenue in San Marcos.

Based on the preliminary investigation, it was determined a vehicle was preforming a backing movement and struck a 74-year old female pedestrian. The pedestrian was transported to a local hospital for non-life threatening, but serious injuries. The driver, a 73-year old woman, stayed at the scene and was cooperative with the investigation.

Alcohol and/or drugs were not a factor in the collision. The San Marcos Traffic Division is handling the investigation.
