SYNOPSIS:

On 08/26/19, at about 4:45 pm the Sheriff's Department and West Hills High School Administration were made aware of a concerning student remark referencing a possible act of violence. The student remark was heard by other students in class around 10:30 am. In conjunction with school staff and the School Resource Officer, this was swiftly and effectively handled by deputies. The 15 year old student has been identified. No arrests have been made. At this time there is no threat to school safety. The investigation is ongoing.
