## Synopsis:

On September 27, 2019, at approximately 2100 hours, deputies from the North Coastal Sheriff's Transit Enforcement Unit responded to a report of an AMTRAK Train vs. vehicle collision. The collision occurred on the railroad tracks near Mile Post Marker 266.3 in the city of San Diego, Ca. A northbound AMTRAK train traveled between 35-45 miles per hour when it struck a 2005 Toyota Prius which was stuck on the rail road tracks on the right of way. The female driver of the Prius had safely exited the Prius prior to the collision. No injuries were reported.
