

## San Diego County Sheriff's Department Homicide Detail Media Information

**SUBJECT:** Homicide Investigation

The following information is fragmentary and has not been completely verified. It is based, in part, on hearsay and is intended for early information use rather than being a formal investigative report.

On Wednesday, January 3, 2017, just after 12:00 p.m., deputies from the Ramona Sheriff's Substation responded to a 911 call regarding unknown trouble at 24478 Del Amo Road in Ramona. The caller told dispatchers there was a murder and a suicide at that address, then hung up. The caller has not been identified. When deputies arrived, they found an adult female, later identified as twenty-two-year- old Samantha Hayes Benegas of El Cajon, deceased at that location. They also found an adult male, later identified as thirty-five-year-old Bryan Hinkle of Ramona, nearby with a serious wound. Hinkle was airlifted to a local hospital for treatment, but is not expected to survive. A weapon was recovered at the scene.

The Sheriff's Homicide Detail was called to the scene and has assumed investigative responsibility. The case is being investigated as a homicide.

The San Diego County Medical Examiner's Office completed the autopsy on Samantha Benegas and preliminary results have been released. The cause of death has been ruled a gunshot wound and the manner of death is homicide.
