## SYNOPSIS:

On February 22, 2018, at about 8:24 p.m., Sheriff's deputies were made aware of comments posted online reference threats to "SHS". Community members were afraid the threats were directed towards Santana High School. A thorough investigation was conducted and no credible threats towards Santana High School were discovered. It was determined the "SHS" threat was directed towards Springfield High School in Springfield, Ohio. This message has been circulating on social media since at least February 19<sup>th</sup>, and has caused safety concerns throughout the country.

In an abundance of caution, deputies conducted extra patrols and walked on campus throughout the day for an increased presence.
