

WANTED: Suspect Responsible for Credit Card and Identity Theft

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the Poway Sheriff's Station are asking for the public's help to locate an unknown suspect wanted in connection with using a stolen credit card and identity theft.

On January 14, 2018, at about 11:30 a.m., an unknown female suspect stole a wallet from a woman who was shopping at the Vons located at 13438 Poway Road in Poway. Within an hour, the suspect used four of the victim's credit/debit cards to purchase several Visa gift cards and miscellaneous items in excess of \$6,300 at the Target store located in Poway and two Rite Aid stores located in San Diego.

The suspect is described as a Black woman between 20 to 30-years-old with a thin build and dark hair in a ponytail. She was last seen wearing a black/white jacket with the word "Pink" on the front, blue denim jeans, and black shoes.
