SYNOPSIS:

On March 19th, 2018, at approximately 2220 hours, deputies from the Sheriff's Transit Enforcement Unit responded to an AMTRAK Train vs. pedestrian collision. The collision occurred on the railroad track, just south of the 400 block of Tamarack Avenue, in the City of Carlsbad. A southbound AMTRAK train was traveling at approximately 70-80 miles per hour when an adult male was struck by the train. The male suffered serious injuries and was pronounced deceased at the scene. It remains unclear as to why the male was struck by the train. Anyone with information about this case can call the Sheriff's Department's non-emergency line at (858) 565-5200.
