News Conference for the Unsolved Murder of Nikki Alexandra Benedict

\$1,000 REWARD

May 1, 2018

San Diego County Crime Stoppers, the San Diego County Sheriff's Department's Homicide Unit and members of Nikki Benedict's family will hold a news conference today to bring attention to this 51-year-old unsolved homicide.

During the early evening hours of May 1, 1967, 14-year-old Nikki Alexandra Benedict was walking home from a friend's house when she was critically stabbed and left to die in a field across from 12784 Poway Road, Poway. At about 6:30 p.m., an 11-year-old boy discovered Nikki lying in the field. The boy immediately reported what he discovered to his father who owned a market nearby. Deputies from the Poway Sheriff's Station, the Poway Valley Fire Department and ambulance personnel responded to the scene. They rendered first aid and transported Nikki to Palomar Hospital in Escondido where she was pronounced deceased upon arrival.

The on-scene investigation showed evidence of a struggle a short distance from the location of where Nikki Benedict was found.
