SYNOPSIS:

On May 21, 2018, just before 4:00 p.m., deputies responded to a citizen reporting a suspicious person in the area of Avendida Marcella and Calle Ardilla in the Rancho San Diego area.

An adult female was walking alone when a male drove by her staring at her. The male drove up next to her and rolled the window down, but did not say anything. The male drove away when another vehicle approached. The male circled around the block. The male drove up in front of the female as she crossed an intersection and stopped. The male appeared to be about to exit his vehicle. The female flagged down a passing motorist and the male drove away. Deputies responded and searched the area, but did not locate the vehicle.

The suspect was described as an adult male driving a white colored four-door sedan with a broken taillight. The suspect was last seen driving north on Avenida Apolinaria.
