SYNOPSIS:

On May 27, 2018, at 7:26 PM, deputies from the Sheriff's San Marcos Station Traffic Unit responded to a vehicle vs. pedestrian collision near South Rancho Santa Fe Road and West San Marcos Boulevard, in the City of San Marcos.

Based on the preliminary investigation, it was determined a vehicle traveling westbound on West San Marcos Blvd, just west of South Rancho Santa Fe Road, collided with a pedestrian who was walking northbound across the lanes of West San Marcos Blvd. The pedestrian was not inside of a marked crosswalk. The driver of the vehicle remained at the scene of the collision, and is cooperating with the investigation. The pedestrian was transported to a local hospital for serious; but non-life threatening injuries.
