SUBJECT: Homicide in Lemon Grove

LOCATION: 7600 block of Lemon Avenue, Lemon Grove

DATE/TIME: June 21, 2018 / 9:00 p.m.

VICTIM: Withheld, pending family notifications

SUSPECT: Unknown

The following information is fragmentary and has not been completely verified. It is based, in part, on hearsay and is intended for early information use rather than being a formal investigative report.

Last evening, just before 9:00 p.m., Lemon Grove Sheriff's deputies responded to a 9-1-1 call after local residents reported hearing loud banging on their front door in the 7600 block of Lemon Avenue, in the City of Lemon Grove. When deputies arrived they found a man unresponsive and lying on the ground outside the residence. He was seriously injured and had visible injuries to his upper body. Fire department personnel responded and attempted to revive the man but he was pronounced deceased at about 9:19 p.m.

The Sheriff's Homicide Unit was called to the scene and has taken over responsibility for the investigation.

The San Diego County Medical Examiner's Office will conduct an autopsy in order to determine the victim's cause and manner of death. The victim has not yet been identified.
