SYNOPSIS:

The following information is fragmentary and has not been completely verified. It is based, in part, on hearsay and is intended for early information use rather than being a formal investigative report.

On 6/26/18, at approximately 2030 hours, deputies responded to a report of a large fight involving two groups of subjects at the Lomas Santa Fe Plaza, located at the 900 block of Lomas Santa Fe Drive, in Solana Beach. Multiple callers reported the incident with some mentioning the presence of a gun and possibly hearing gunshots. Everyone involved in the fight fled the scene prior to the arrival of Sheriff Deputies. A deputy located one of the involved subjects in a nearby apartment complex and he was detained for questioning. A short time later, a 21 year old male arrived at Palomar Hospital with a non-life threatening gunshot wound to his hand. The subject was interviewed regarding the incident.

During the investigation at least one of the subjects interviewed admitted gang association. Detectives from the North Coastal Narcotics and Gang Division responded to handle the investigation. No arrests have been made and the investigation is ongoing.
