SYNOPSIS:

On August 29, 2018, at 8:05 PM, Sheriff's Deputies responded to a hit and run in the 10200 block of Molino Road in the City of Santee. Upon arrival, Deputies located two female victims lying in the street with major injuries. Deputies were able to determine that three males began to argue with one of the residents and the argument ended up outside. The argument was loud enough to draw the neighbors from their home. The males, who were in their late teens or early twenties, entered a newer model Honda type vehicle and fled southbound on Molino Road. The suspect vehicle entered the east curb line and struck the female victims and fled south on Molino Road. The suspect went east on El Nopal, south on Gem Tree, and east on Beck. At this time, it is not known if the victims were involved in the argument.

During the investigation, one of the males in the suspect vehicle called the Sheriff's Department to turn himself in and to provide the Sheriff's Department with the vehicle that was involved. The extent of the injuries to the victims is currently unknown. The investigation is ongoing.
