**SUBJECT:** Homicide Investigation Update

**LOCATION:** 15000 block of Toya Lane, El Cajon

**DATE/TIME:** August 31, 2018/ 8:13 a.m.

**VICTIM:** David Jordan, age 82

**SUSPECT:** Jean Jordan, age 83

**The following information is fragmentary and has not been completely verified. It is based, in part, on hearsay and is intended for early information use rather than being a formal investigative report.**

Update to a previous release:

The San Diego County Medical Examiner's Office has identified the deceased, notified the next of kin, and provided preliminary autopsy results, which are subject to change.

The decedents have been identified as eighty-two-year-old David Jordan and his wife, eighty-three-year-old Jean Jordan, of Blossom Valley. Mr. Jordan is a well-known football coach in the San Diego area.

David Jordan's cause of death has been determined to be a gunshot wound; his manner of death has been preliminarily ruled a homicide. Jean Jordan's cause of death was a gunshot wound; her manner of death has been preliminarily ruled a suicide.

Prior release:

*Shortly after 8:00 a.m. this morning (August 31, 2018), Alpine Sheriff's deputies responded to a 9-1-1 call of two bodies found inside a residence on Toya Lane in Unincorporated El Cajon. When deputies entered the home they found an elderly Caucasian male and elderly Caucasian female, both obviously deceased. Both had traumatic injuries. The couple was found by an in-home caregiver.*

*The Sheriff's Homicide Unit was called to the scene and has assumed investigative responsibility.*
