SUBJECT: Homicide Investigation in Spring Valley

LOCATION: 10000 Block of Campo Road, Spring Valley

DATE/TIME: September 7, 2018 / 11:53 p.m.

VICTIM: Withheld, pending family notifications

SUSPECT: Unknown

The following information is fragmentary and has not been completely verified. It is based, in part, on hearsay and is intended for early information use rather than being a formal investigative report.

Last evening, just before midnight, Rancho San Diego Sheriff's Station deputies responded to multiple 9-1-1 calls of a shooting in the parking lot of the Jack in the Box in the 10000 block of Campo Road. When they arrived, deputies were unable to locate a victim or any suspects. Moments later, deputies learned that two adult males, both in their early thirties, had arrived at a local hospital with gunshot wounds. Despite lifesaving efforts, one of the males died at the hospital. The other man is expected to survive his injuries.

The Sheriff's Homicide Unit was called to the scene and has taken over responsibility for the investigation.

The San Diego County Medical Examiner's Office will conduct an autopsy in order to determine the victim's cause and manner of death. The victim's name is being withheld pending family notification.
