## **SYNOPSIS:**

On Thursday, September 13, 2018 at about 7:28 pm, Sheriff's Deputies became aware of an Instagram message threatening students not to come to school on Friday September 14, 2018 or they will get hurt. Upon further investigation, in conjunction with school staff and the School Resource Officer, the alleged threat has been unsubstantiated for West Hills High School in Santee.

The original social media post was made by a student of Western Hills High School in Frankfort, KY. The Franklin County Sheriff's Department School Resource Officer (SRO) of Western Hills High School advised the threat was scratched into a stall of the women's restroom yesterday and they have been investigating the threat. Out of an abundance of caution, extra patrols will be conducted at West Hills High School in Santee throughout the day (Friday September 14, 2018).
