## Saving Lives with Trauma Kits and Rescue Sleds

WHAT: The Sheriff's Department will showcase tools to help keep deputies and the

public safe in case of an active shooter incident.

WHEN: Monday, October 1<sup>st</sup> at 10:00 a.m.

> This date will mark one year since the deadliest mass shooting in U.S. history happened in Las Vegas, Nevada. 58 people were killed when a man opened fire from a casino hotel window into a crowd at a country music

festival.

WHERE: 810 Imperial Beach Boulevard, Imperial Beach

Look for deputies in the grassy area near the Imperial Beach Library

WHO: **Detective Kristy Drilling** – She rendered first aid to victims of the Las Vegas

> shooting and helped get them to a hospital. She also ushered the crowd to avoid getting trampled and found a safe location to seek cover from the

hail of bullets.
