Saving Lives with Trauma Kits and Rescue Sleds

WHAT: The Sheriff's Department will showcase tools to help keep deputies and the public safe in case of an active shooter incident.

WHEN: **Monday, October 1st at 10:00 a.m.**
This date will mark one year since the deadliest mass shooting in U.S. history happened in Las Vegas, Nevada. 58 people were killed when a man opened fire from a casino hotel window into a crowd at a country music festival.

WHERE: **810 Imperial Beach Boulevard, Imperial Beach**
Look for deputies in the grassy area near the Imperial Beach Library
Parking is available along 8th Street

WHO: **Detective Kristy Drilling** – She rendered first aid to victims of the Las Vegas shooting and helped get them to a hospital. She also ushered the crowd to avoid getting trampled and found a safe location to seek cover from the hail of bullets.

Corporal Dan Sloppy and **Deputy Cleve Willis** will talk about the department's use of **trauma kits** and **rescue sleds**.

VISUALS: Demonstration on how deputies use the rescue sled and static display of the trauma kit.
