Sexually Violent Predator's Placement Hearing Date – October 12, 2018

The hearing date for the proposed placement of Sexually Violent Predator (SVP) Alvin Quarles will be held:

October 12, 2018 9:00 a.m. Department 2204 San Diego Superior Court 1100 Union Street San Diego, CA 92101

The Sheriff's Department, the District Attorney's Office and the SAFE Task Force are not responsible for the selection of the proposed site. The selection process and approval is the responsibility of the Department of State Hospitals and San Diego Superior Court.



On August 22, 2018 the Department of State Hospitals (DSH) proposed placement of Alvin Quarles at 43050 Desert Rose Ranch Road, Jacumba Hot Springs, CA 91934. Selection of the proposed placement location is the sole responsibility of DSH and the San Diego County Superior Court. However, under Welfare & Institutions Code section 6609.1, the public is permitted to comment on the proposed location before it is finalized by the Court.

Jacumba Hot Springs, California is an unincorporated community in the southeastern area of San Diego County. Per the United States Census, the population of Jacumba Hot Springs, formerly known as Jacumba, was 561 in 2010 while the neighboring community of Boulevard had a population of 315 during the same time period. The property of interest is located within the San Diego Sheriff Department's (SDSO) jurisdiction, particularly the area patrolled by deputy sheriffs assigned to the Boulevard / Jacumba Substation. This substation is staffed by resident deputies who live and work in the area.

With the court hearing scheduled for October 12, 2018, the SAFE Task Force will be accepting public comments about the proposed placement to be included in the formal response to the Court.

The Sheriff's Department and SAFE Task Force are not responsible for the selection of the proposed site. The selection process is the sole responsibility of the Department of State Hospitals and San Diego Superior Court.

You may submit your comments through any of the methods listed below. Public comment will be accepted between the dates of August 22, 2018 and September 5, 2018. These comments will be forwarded to DSH and to the Superior Court before the Hearing on this matter. Public comment will also be accepted at the hearing.
