SYNOPSIS:

On November 2, 2018, the Sheriff's Department, Poway Station, received information from concerned parents via the Poway TIP Line and the Sheriff's Communication Center, about threats that had been made towards several students at Poway High School. The threats originated from another student.

After an investigation by deputies, including the Poway School Resource Officer and Juvenile Detective, the investigators determined that during an argument with a group of students, one student threatened to bring a gun to school and shoot the other students.

Deputies identified the student who made the threat. Deputies arrested the student at his home and booked him into Juvenile Hall for 422 PC - Criminal Threats. Deputies did not locate a firearm.

The Sheriff's Department investigates all school threats vigorously and encourages community members to continue to report incidents such as this one to law enforcement.
