SUBJECT: Deputy Involved Shooting

The following information is fragmentary and has not been completely verified. It is based, in part, on hearsay and is intended for early information use rather than being a formal investigative report.

Today at about 2:50 p.m., the Sheriff's Communication Center received 911 calls about an unknown trouble occurring in the apartment complex at 2660 Alpine Blvd., Alpine. One of the callers indicated there was a subject yelling that he wanted to kill someone. Deputies were dispatched to the apartment complex and arrived at approximately 2:58 p.m.

The deputies attempted to contact a subject in one of the apartments. A male subject in his 30's exited the apartment with a knife in his hand and advanced toward the deputies. As a result and fearing for their safety, a deputy involved shooting occurred. Following the shooting, deputies rendered first aid to the subject and called for paramedics to respond. When the paramedics arrived, they took over life saving measures. Despite life saving efforts, the subject was pronounced deceased at approximately 3:19 p.m.

The facts surrounding the shooting are currently under investigation by the Sheriff's Homicide Unit. The investigation is still in the early stages, but more than one deputy was involved in the shooting. The involved deputies were not injured. The investigation is continuing.
