**SUBJECT:** Deputy Involved Shooting Update

**SUSPECT:** Daniel Ayala, age thirty-one

**The following information is fragmentary and has not been completely verified. It is based, in part, on hearsay and is intended for early information use rather than being a formal investigative report.**

Updated information to prior releases:

The deputies involved in this event are all assigned to the Alpine Substation. They have been identified as Deputy Kevin Nulton, Deputy Sean McGillicuddy, and Sergeant Chris Katra.

Deputy Nulton has been employed with the San Diego Sheriff's Department for ten years. Deputy McGillicuddy has been employed with the San Diego Sheriff's Department for twelve years. Sergeant Katra has been employed with the San Diego Sheriff's Department for eighteen years.

Information from prior releases:

*On November 12, 2018, at about 2:50 p.m., the Sheriff's Communication Center received 911 calls about an unknown trouble occurring in the apartment complex at 2660 Alpine Blvd., Alpine. One of the callers indicated there was a subject yelling that he wanted to kill someone. Deputies were dispatched to the apartment complex and arrived at approximately 2:58 p.m.*

### Media Information

*The deputies attempted to contact a subject in one of the apartments. A male subject in his 30's exited the apartment with a knife in his hand and advanced toward the deputies. As a result and fearing for their safety, a deputy involved shooting occurred. Following the shooting, deputies rendered first aid to the subject and called for paramedics to respond. When the paramedics arrived, they took over life saving measures. Despite life saving efforts, the subject was pronounced deceased at approximately 3:19 p.m. He has been identified as thirty-one-year-old Daniel Ayala.*
