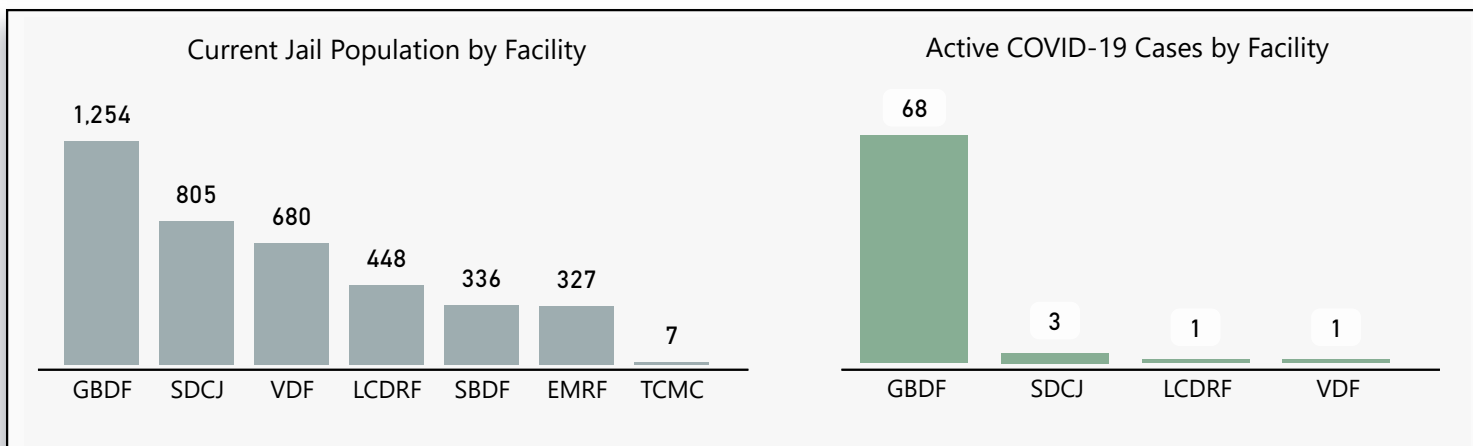

- Totals are subject to change throughout the day due to population fluctuations and updates made to medical directives, patient conditions, and housing locations.
- Active Cases In Custody is the number of individuals currently in custody who are confirmed COVID-19 positive.
- Individuals in Isolation for Precautions are individuals who are being monitored by medical personnel either due to presenting COVID-like symptoms or due to possible exposure.
- Positive cases are tied to the facility where the individual is currently housed/located and may not represent the housing location where the individual was initially tested.
- Data from all San Diego County detention facilities are included in this report. San Diego Central Jail (SDCJ); George Bailey Detention Facility (GBDF); East Mesa Re-Entry Facility (EMRF); Vista Detention Facility (VDF); Las Colinas Detention and Re-Entry Facility (LCDRF); South Bay Detention Facility (SBDF); & Facility 8 Detention Facility (FAC8).
- Tri-City Medical Center (TCMC): these counts include individuals admitted to the hospital for reasons unrelated to COVID-19, as well as individuals admitted to the hospital as a direct result of complications arising from COVID-19. Please note that medical privacy laws prevent the sharing of private medical information.
