## Dear Director Grubb:

On February 8, 2019, ANAB granted accreditation to the San Diego County Sheriff's Department - Regional Crime Laboratory - Calibration in the Field of Forensic Science Calibration. This decision was based upon the documentation provided in the assessment report and in accordance with the recommendation of Lead Assessor Michael Hurley. ANAB is satisfied that your organization has met or exceeded the accreditation requirements set forth in ISO/IEC 17025:2005, the ANAB 17025:2005 Forensic Science Calibration Accreditation Requirements:2017 and your own documented management system.
