Fatal Single Vehicle Traffic Collision

On Friday June 17, 2022, at 5:25 am, the Oceanside Police Department responded to single vehicle traffic collision at the intersection of Cannon Road and Lake Boulevard. Upon arrival, Oceanside Fire Department personnel attempted life saving measures, however, the driver was pronounced dead at the scene. The identity of the deceased has not been released pending family notification.

Oceanside officers discovered the vehicle contained several gallons of chlorine and other swimming pool related chemicals. Several hazardous material teams responded to the scene and the intersection is closed to assist in cleanup.

The Oceanside Police Department's Major Accident Investigation Team responded to investigate the collision. At this time, it is unknown if alcohol or speed were a factor in this collision.
