


These incidents were determined, upon medical review, to be a result of or related to a drug overdose based on the primary medical diagnosis presented by the treating emergency room. Incidents that ultimately were due to other types of medical emergencies or conditions, based on the primary hospital diagnosis, are excluded from this report. Totals are subject to change due to data reconciliation and updates made to incident reports. Percentages may not total 100 due to rounding.
