Dear Licensee:

Persons approved for a CCW license are subject to the following:

IMPORTANT: State Law requires that you notify the Issuing Agency within ten (10) days of any changes to the information on the license. You must carry the approved DOF 4501 card. *It is your responsibility to notify the Sheriff's License Division if you are arrested, issued a Restraining Order against you (temporary or permanent) or when your weapons are confiscated by a law enforcement agency.*

In addition, while carrying a concealed weapon, **A LICENSEE SHALL NOT:**

1. Carry a concealed weapon in a prohibited location. (Penal Code Sections 25850(a), 26230, 171(b).
2. Consume and/or be under the influence of any intoxicating liquor, drug, or controlled substance. (Penal Code Sections 26200, 647(f), Vehicle Code 23152 (a), (b), Health & Safety Code 11053 to 11055).
3. Be in a place having a primary purpose of dispensing alcoholic beverages for on-site consumption. (Penal Code Section 26200).
4. Refuse to show the license or surrender the concealed weapon to **ANY** peace officer/law enforcement officer upon demand (Penal Code Section 25850(b)).
5. Impede any peace officer/law enforcement officer in the performance of his/her duties. (Penal Code Sections 148(a)(1), 69(a)).
6. Present himself/herself as a peace officer/law enforcement officer to any person unless you are, in fact, a peace officer/law enforcement officer. (Penal Code Sections 26200, 538d).
7. Unjustifiably display a concealed weapon. (Penal Code Sections 26200, 417, 245).
8. Carry a concealed weapon not listed on the permit or for which you are not the recorded owner. (Penal Code Sections 26200, 25400).
9. Carry a concealed weapon at times or circumstances other than those specified in the permit. (Penal Code Sections 25850(a), 171(b).
10. Leave a handgun in an unattended vehicle without properly storing the firearm as required by State, County, City laws and ordinances. (Penal Code Section 25610).
11. Carry more than two firearms at one time. (Penal Code Section 26200).

If you, as a CCW licensed person, are named in any investigation that involves a crime which could result in temporary or permanent firearms/ammunition prohibitions, your CCW could be suspended. Such investigations may include laws of the United States and/or the State of California involving narcotics violation investigations. (Reference Penal Code Sections 29800, 29805, 29815, 29825). In the interest of public and officer safety your CCW license may be suspended until such investigation is either adjudicated by a court or dispositioned by the investigating law enforcement agency.

By signing this letter, you acknowledge that you are subject to these restrictions and conditions, and that any violation thereof may result in the immediate invalidation and/or revocation of your license to carry a concealed weapon.
